




XO Time - week 7

 Today I am sending the last challenge about Turtle Art! Next week I will explore another activity in my XO laptop.


Below is the answer for the week 5's challenge, sent by my friends from Kagugu Primary School!

My challenge for you this week is:
 to teach the Turtle to draw a sun like mine and show me the blocks that you used.



TurtleArt brings together art, math, and programming. Programming involves dragging, dropping and connecting puzzle piece shaped blocks. Math is used to create and explore pattern, shape and texture and art is the result.

Can you send your sun but showing the blocks to my email? Are you able to teach the Turtle to write the word **SUN**? Show me!!!

To send your work:
 Once you are done, save your work, by pressing "keep." This will save your project to the journal. Once you have saved, click on your journal. You should see your project as the most recent on the list. It should be called "turtle art activity" click on this writing and change the name to your name.
 Then find a location with Internet access and log onto your email. Open a new message and click "attach file" or "attachment," etc. You should look for your project. Double click on your project, so that it is attached to your email. Write anything in the message that you want me to know about you. For example, how old are you? What grade are you in?
