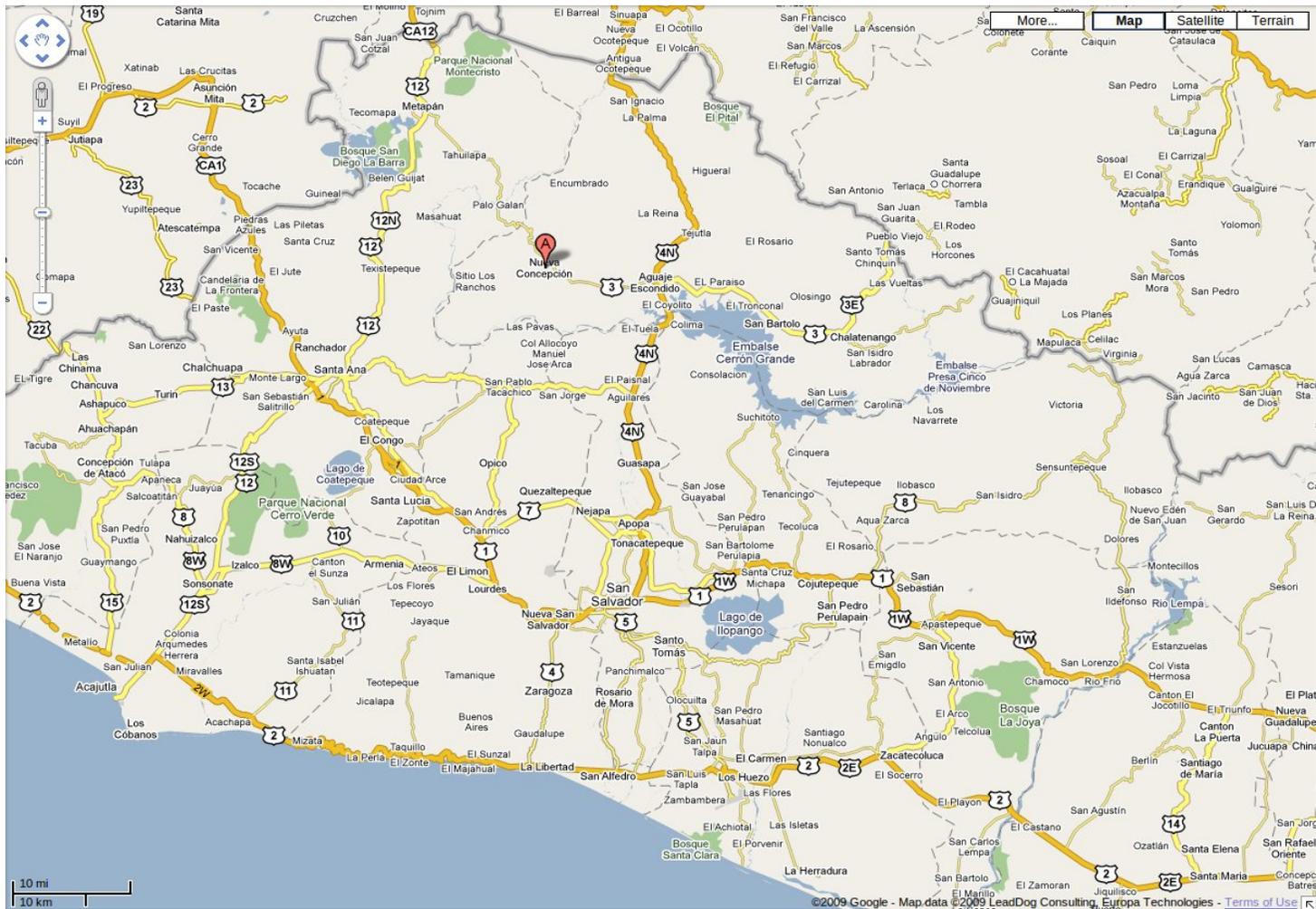
Who?

- La Cooperativa Juan Chacon
- Formed at the end of the civil war in early 1990s
- 30 some ex-combatants & families
- Each one given small piece of land and housing materials
- No previous experience as farmers
- Members joined their resources together to create co-op
- Agricultural production focusing on sugar cane and milk
